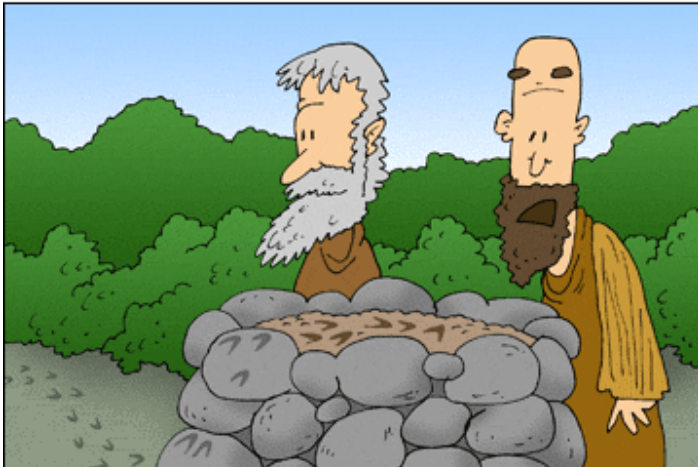
PADDED CHAIRS AVAILABLE: At the south end of the downstairs Fellowship Hall are some surplus padded chairs free for the taking.
