**EXIT STRATEGY:** When you leave the church, please make sure that lights are out, fans are turned off, and that the building is secure. Thanks - Adriana.

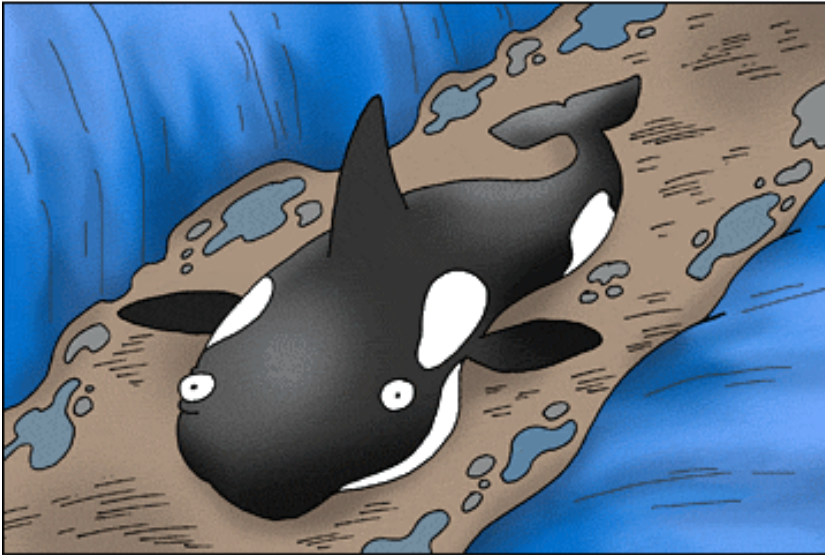
