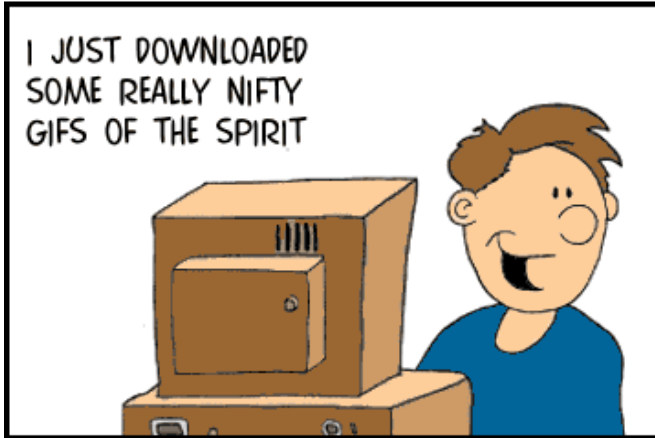
ECHURCHGIVING: In addition to writing checks or giving cash to FTPC, we now have several ways you can give online:
