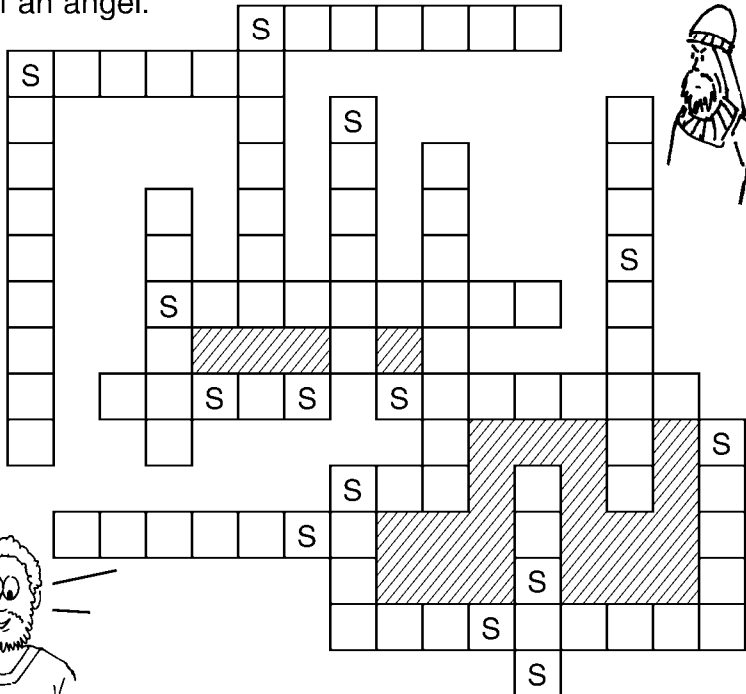




God's workers often run into serious difficulties, but God is always with them.

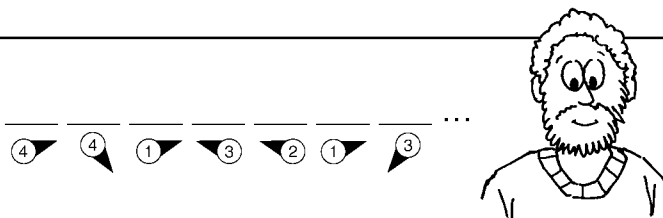
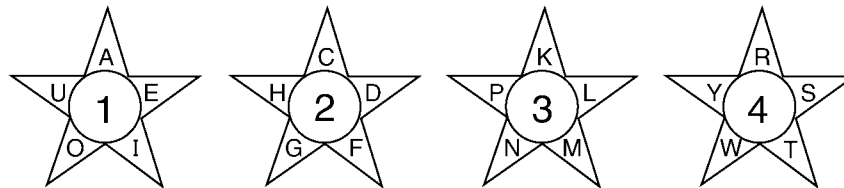
