In this case, sharing the gospel in Athens, a city focused on philosophical speculations, he uses that framework to present the gospel.]

*Friday, Feb. 5 – **Psalms 67*** [This psalm reveals a heart that desires to share the good news of the gospel to the nations. Having the attitude that we are blessed in order to share Christ with others will motivate us to share in the right spirit.]
