Text: *Matthew 28:1-6*

SUMMARY OF SERMON: As the women arrive at the empty tomb of Jesus they meet an angel from God. The angel affirms that the tomb is empty because Jesus has risen “just as he said.” Then there is a wonderful invitation to “come and see.” This is not about casual observance. This is a call to put faith in the risen Lord Jesus.

RELATED BIBLE PASSAGES FOR THE COMING WEEK [The Bible readings this week are examples of God’s inviting people to “come and see” and put faith in Christ.]

Monday, Mar. 28 – **John 1:43-51** [God’s invitation to Nathaniel to “come and see” who Jesus really is given through Philip, an encouraging reminder that we can be used by the Holy Spirit to bring people to Christ.]

Tuesday, Mar. 29 - **Psalms 66** [This psalm of praise invites both individual and corporate praise to God from all peoples. V.5 is the invitation to come and see God’s awesome works on our behalf, which culminate in the mission of Jesus Christ.]

Wednesday, Mar. 30 – **John 4:27-38** [After Jesus brought salvation to the Samaritan woman she became a great witness for Him by inviting other townsfolk, v.29, to come and see the One who had transformed her.]

Thursday, Mar. 31 – **Isaiah 55:1-7** [In this great invitation from God in Isaiah the “come and see” are not right together. The gracious ‘come’ is in v.1 and the ‘see’ is in v.4. The reference (v.3) is to Messiah, the Son of David, and the invitation is to see in Him all that He is.]

Friday, April 1 - **Psalms 46** [This psalm focuses on the stability of trusting in God in the midst of the world’s chaos. In v.8 we are invited to see God’s judgments and actions on earth in terminology that elicits thoughts of the Second Coming.]

Saturday, April 2 – **John 1:29-34** [The “come” in this passage is seen in v.33 when God had invited John to watch for Messiah and how to identify Him. When John “saw” Jesus, v.29, he saw with discernment recognizing that Jesus was Messiah, the Lamb of God.]
