Texts: I Corinthians 12:4-11
SPRING 2016 SERIES:
The Christian and Spiritual Gifts

SUMMARY OF SERMON: I Corinthians 12 presents a list of nine “manifestational” gifts. These gifts, unlike motivational gifts, are only experienced by Christians and are used in a given situation for a given purpose. They are Holy Spirit inspired gifts that manifest the presence of God to His people. Three of them (faith, the gifts of healings, and the gift of miraculous powers) are power gifts that reveal the hand of God, the focus this week.

RELATED BIBLE PASSAGES FOR THE COMING WEEK [The Bible readings this week illustrate instances where the supernatural power gifts of God are used.]

*Monday, June 20 – **II Kings 8:1-6*** [This little known story is a good example of the gift of faith. The woman and her family risked everything by following Elisha’s advice. But she trusted the Lord’s words through Elisha and her faith was vindicated.]

*Tuesday, June 21 – **Luke 18:31-34*** [Jesus displayed the gift of faith in many ways but perhaps most powerfully in knowing that His Father’s will was that He, though innocent, would suffer death on our behalf. Yet, Jesus fully believed that He would be raised up again and be forever reunited in full fellowship with His Father.]

*Wednesday, June 22 – **Exodus 15:22-27*** [In this vignette we get a foretaste of Jesus’ healing ministry. Water, which would have sickened the people, is made pure. God then promises that by following His ways we are spared from many diseases resulting from worldly life-styles. Also, that He is the Lord who heals us.]

*Thursday, June 23 – **Acts 3:1-10*** [There are many examples of Jesus exercising the gifts of healings in different ways. What we see here is that healings continued (and continue) through His followers.]

*Friday, June 24 – **Exodus 15:1-21*** [This song of Moses and Miriam celebrates the miracle of God opening the Red Sea to allow the Israelites to pass through and then having the waters destroy the Egyptian army. This miracle is referred to frequently throughout the OT.]

*Saturday, June 25 – **Luke 5:1-11*** [The gift of miraculous powers, here illustrated in the miracle of the huge catch of fish, is often used by God to draw people into faith in Jesus Christ or, in this case, a deeper surrender to the Lord and His purpose in our lives.]
